Board Order

This is the decision of the Penlac hearing panel (the "Panel") on a motion brought by Board Staff for the production of documents in this proceeding and for leave to file reply evidence in relation thereto (the "Motion").

The Panel, having heard the parties on the Motion and having decided to grant a variation on the relief sought on the Motion, hereby orders that:

Production of Documents

- The Respondent shall produce to Board Staff such data and protocols used in the production of the studies referred in these proceedings as Trials 312 and 313 (the "Data") as are in the possession, power or control of the Respondent, and in this regard, the Respondent shall use its best efforts to obtain the Data from any affiliated or related entities or other persons that the Respondent might reasonably expect to have the Data in their possession, power or control.
- The Respondent shall file an affidavit in this proceeding with respect to the Data that are in its possession, power or control, and with respect to its efforts to obtain the Data in accordance with paragraph 1 hereof.

Reply Evidence

- Board Staff shall have leave to file Reply Evidence pertaining to the Data.
- 4. The Respondent shall have the right to file evidence that responds to any evidence that might be filed by Board Staff in accordance with paragraph 3.
